*Notes: The bread you bake with your hands becomes the Body of Christ. What a great privilege! What a beautiful gift you present to the Lord!
Of course, the Prosforon/Prosfora should always be fresh – never frozen – since it is given as a precious gift to God to become His Immaculate Body.
The Prosforon/Prosfora is/are needed at church in advance of the scheduled Liturgy.
The Priest starts the Service of the Proskomidi before Matins, so bringing the Prosforon/Prosfora to church the evening before is a good guideline to follow.
On Sundays, two loaves are normally required to ensure we have enough both for the Oblation and for Antidoron.
On Weekdays a small loaf suffices:*

¹ *One small Prosforon will be sufficient.*

² *For the early Morning Liturgies, the small Prosforon must be at church the previous evening.*

³ *For the Evening Presanctified Liturgy, the small Prosforon must be at church before 5:00 pm that day.*
